- 1995** **Surgical Information Systems** (SIS) and **LocumTenens.com** founded.
- 1999** LocumTenens.com launches the first free physician job board for both permanent and temporary physicians across all specialties.
- 2000** **Jackson Healthcare** established through combination of LocumTenens.com and Surgical Information Systems.
- 2001** SIS clients rate the company's surgery scheduling/management system highest in comparison study by leading healthcare IT industry research and consulting firm KLAS.
- 2002** **Premier Anesthesia** founded.
- 2003** Three new companies founded:
- **Jackson & Harris** retained physician search
 - **StatCom**, which provides patient flow management software for hospitals and health systems
